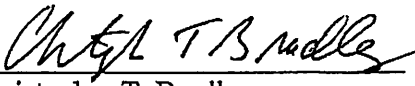

STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

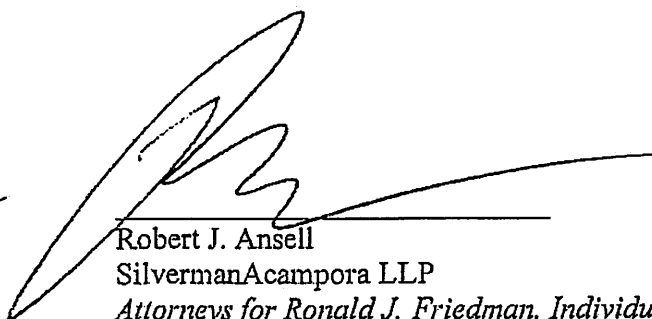

Rules of Civil Procedure.

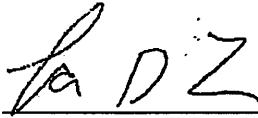
